From the Comedy Stage Straight Into the Mosh Pit — German Comedian and Entertainer BÜLENT CEYLAN Unleashes His Second Heavy Metal Album!

As one of the country's best-known comedians and entertainers, **BÜLENT CEYLAN** has been performing on the nation's biggest stages for over 25 years and holds a very special place in the hearts of his fans, thanks to his humor and down-to-earth manner. With his talent, he brings a smile to people's faces, offers them an escape from everyday life, and leaves them feeling light-hearted and carefree. Bülent has at least two passions: Alongside comedy, he is devoted heart and soul to metal, and not just as a fan. Bülent is a metalhead through and through! In 2024, the Mannheim-based artist released his debut album, ***Ich liebe Menschen*** (Translation: *I Love People*), followed by the tour of the same name with his four-piece band. In September 2025, he secured a record deal with leading rock and metal label Napalm Records. A newly-forged partnership now crowns Bülent's second studio album, ***B.L.N.T.***, which is set for release on 11 September 2026.

In collaboration with Christian Neander, Martin Fliegenschmidt and Henning Verlage, twelve songs were created that reflect the artist's multi-faceted nature. With ***B.L.N.T.***, Bülent Ceylan strikes a balance between tongue-in-cheek humor and social commentary, offering listeners both entertainment and meaningful messages alike. For instance, *"Fünf vor Zwölf"* (Translation: "Five to Twelve") addresses the urgency of taking a closer look before the final minutes slip away. The closing track, *"Am Ende gut,"* (Translation: "Everything's fine in the end") advocates openness, tolerance, and never giving up hope, no matter how strong the headwind may be, while *"Leck mich Tag"* (Translation: "Screw You Day") stands as a blunt statement against those whose opinions really should not be taken seriously. The previously released single *"Diktatürk"* (his current comedy show goes by the same name) is a hard-hitting industrial track brimming with raw metal energy, while its provocative lyrics showcase Bülent's razor-sharp insight and willingness to take a stand.

On ***B.L.N.T.***, no two tracks are alike. Alongside the songs already mentioned, there is the album opener *"Stumpf ist Trumpf"* (Translation: "Simple is best") with its 'just switch off your brain' attitude, as well as *"Lange Haare,"* (Engl. Long Hair) where the title says it all. Further highlights come in the form of the two powerful ballads *"Wir haben gelebt"* (Translation: "We Have Lived") and *"Wolfsherz,"* (Translation: "Wolf's Heart") which may slow the tempo but not the intensity. The former invites listeners to pause and look back: Who was I? What am I leaving behind?

For the equally emotional *"Wolfsherz,"* Bülent Ceylan secured none other than the Heavy Metal Queen herself, Doro Pesch. Her smoky yet sensitive voice guarantees absolute goosebumps and unmistakable recognition value. With the cheekily rocking *"Randale und Radau,"* (Riot and Rampage) all signs point to a change of pace, as Bülent welcomes Michael Rhein, frontman of German mediaeval rock band In Extremo, and invites everyone to let loose completely!

Following performances at the legendary Wacken Open Air, at the Scorpions' anniversary concert, and at Metal Holidays, as well as through his collaboration with the German edition of Metal Hammer—at whose 2024 awards ceremony **BÜLENT CEYLAN** hosted the evening—he once again proves his standing as a serious musician with ***B.L.N.T.*** and cements his place in the ranks of heavy metal. ***B.L.N.T.*** has humor, brains, and above all else, one thing in particular: plenty of heavy sounds. An album for heavy metal fans and for all those who share Bülent's passion, openness, and keen eye for society.
